The screech of tires and blood curdling howl said it all, Buddy was hit. He must have gotten out and made his way into the street. By the time the driver saw him, it was already too late.

Buddy's leg was mangled. He couldn't move; he was down for the count. Heavy panting was all that Buddy could muster up.

Buddy's owners had the dog's leg set, but he had lost his job and realized he could not continue to provide the kind of care Buddy needed. So he brought Buddy to Noah's Ark so we could find Buddy a new home. At first Buddy seemed to be healing but an infection set in and our veterinarian recommended that we amputate the injured leg in order to save Buddy's life.

Prior to the accident, Buddy was a healthy Boxer/Mastiff/Rottweiler mix. He was a strong dog that loved to run and play. And you know what? He still is. Today, thanks to that life-saving surgery, Buddy is still a strong, healthy, playful dog that is full of life and love. He has recovered from the surgery and can run and play with his new family as well as any four-legged dog. The treatment Buddy received was expensive, but at Noah's Ark we believe that dogs and cats whose medical conditions can be treated should receive that treatment and should be given a chance to find a loving home.

Buddy was lucky. Noah's Ark was able to help him because supporters like you believe in helping pets like Buddy – the ones that need special care. I hope you will help not only the Buddys who come to Noah's Ark but all the dogs and cats that need our help. Because all of the homeless pets that come to us need some kind of veterinary care...from routine check ups and vaccines to keep them healthy, to spaying or neutering, to medications for pets with chronic but treatable conditions.

As little as \$26 will get one cat or dog vaccinated, \$304 will get 2 male dogs neutered and \$750 will pay for the daily shots that will treat a dog with Addison's disease while we look for the right family to continue his care so he can live a long, happy, normal life.

Any amount you choose to give will help us provide quality care to our resident homeless pets.
